

BRITISH SOLO TRIALS CHAMPIONSHIP

All roads lead to Hook Woods Trials Centre in West Horsley, Surrey on Sunday 7th September when the Thames MCC are promoting the sixth round of the British Solo Trials Championship.

The trial attracts the top adult riders from around the UK together with the top 5 youth riders; Sam Connor is planning to enter the Championship class alongside local riders Graham Jarvis, Alexz Wigg and Sam Haslam. Ben Morphett heads the elite youth riders with Mika Vesterinen, Jason Bayliss, James Fry and Ben Wibberley amongst the entries in the Expert Class.

Clerk of the Course Jim Connor has planned 12 challenging sections to be attempted 3 times starting at 10.00am on the Sunday with a practice lap due to start at 3.00pm on the Saturday. It has been decided, once again, to run the Championship using the FIM marking system as in World Championship Trials, this system requires 3 people to observe at each section, Jim Connor is assembling these observers for the trial and is also looking for volunteers to assist on Saturday for the practice lap (offers of help to Jim 01483 285727 or Bob Brown 01895 638738).

Spectators are welcome on both days but there will be an entry fee of £3 on Sunday and £2 on Saturday, programmes cost £2.

Hook Wood Trials Centre will be signposted from the A246 2 miles east of the junction with the A25/A247 and 400yards west of the Bell & Colville Roundabout in West Horsley.
